MINDA RELEASES DRAFT MASTER PLAN FOR BRIGHTON CAMPUS

South Australia's oldest provider of services for the intellectually disabled, Minda Incorporated, has released its draft Master Plan for the redevelopment of its Brighton campus.

The draft Master Plan is aimed at meeting the future needs of South Australians with intellectual disabilities with the provision of purpose-built accommodation on the 28-hectare site.

The draft Master Plan has been under development for the past two years and is now open for public consultation.

Minda's Acting CEO, Robert Cairney, said the draft Master Plan provided a high level vision of what the Brighton site will look like in the future.

"The draft Master Plan will enable Minda to continue to provide purpose-built accommodation for South Australians with an intellectual disability," he said.

"The draft plan also takes into account the need to include commercial opportunities to offset the majority of the costs for the redevelopment.

"Minda's Brighton campus has been the jewel in our crown for more than 100 years. We are pleased to present our draft Master Plan so this can continue."

The Minda draft Master Plan will be open for public consultation until Friday 30 April.
